

IELTS PREP Course

Covid-19 Health & Safety Plan Addendum

Updated: December 10, 2020

Staff, students, and volunteers involved in the IELTS PREP Course are required to adhere to the [MRCS COVID-19 Health & Safety Plan](#).

The following rules are a program-specific addition to the guidelines set forth in the [MRCS COVID-19 Health & Safety Plan](#), which adheres to the requirements established by the BC Ministry of Health and the recommendations of local health authorities.

Contact Tracing

- Daily attendance is mandatory for Covid-19 contact tracing records.
- No visitors will be allowed apart from IELTS PREP students.

Social Distancing

- Students must remain a distance of 2 metres apart from other individuals in the classroom.
- The designating seating plan for the IELTS course will ensure that all students are seated at least 2 metres apart.

Facial Coverings

- Teachers and students are, at all times, required to wear a fabric mask or face covering which covers the entirety of the mouth and the nose.

Sanitization

- The classroom will be sanitized before and after each use.
- The students and instructor must sanitize their hands before entering and after exiting the classroom.
- Students and the instructor must bring their own materials to class.
- Do not touch library books.
- Do not borrow any materials or office supplies.
- Students and the teacher may eat or drink as long as they are doing so in a non-distracting and sanitary manner.

Student Aides

- Volunteer Student Aides are approved to join the classes.
- Student Aides are, at all times, required to wear a fabric mask or face covering which covers the entirety of the mouth and the nose.
