You will automatically be enrolled in the following required courses:

- Semester One
 - English First Peoples 11 (Meets the Ministry of Education's Indigenous-focused graduation requirement, as well as the English 12 requirements for post-secondary admissions).
 - French 11 (unless on an individualized learning plan)
- Linear
 - o CLE 11
 - o Bible 11

Additional Information:

- You need a minimum of 92 credits for graduation from MRCS
- The BC Ministry of Education requires 80 credits for a Dogwood Diploma
- You must choose one course within each option for a full course load as per our school requirements
- It is a good idea to do a Science 11 or 12 within your Grade 11 year to have that ministry mandated requirement met
- It is a good idea to do a Socials 11 or 12 within your Grade 11 year to have that ministry mandated requirement met
- The Teacher's Assistant program requires an application and screening process and is not a guarantee. You may also only be a TA once per year and you MUST ensure you are meeting your Grade 11/12 level course requirements first. Priority is given to Grade 12 students over Grade 11 students. Teachers are also allowed to say no to a TA request
- We will consider enrolling students in one online option per year with the following conditions:
 - Students in Grade 11 and 12 may only swap one course for an online option each year
 - The course cannot be one that we currently offer in our schedule, but must be one that is not currently available at MRCS
 - The student and parents must sign a contract stating that the student is responsible for the completion of all work and meeting deadlines. If the student is not able to complete their first unit within our school's course change deadline, they will be asked to enrol in an in-person course within our schedule
- Courses with an * are required prerequisites for the Grade 12 level course of the same content
- The following courses do not, at this time, have a teacher as we are still looking for a HS Math and Science Teacher and would be offered in a group online format with an adult supervisor taking them through modules on a scheduled time frame and providing in-class organizational support, check ins, and attendance monitoring. Please pray for the Lord to provide a teacher for us!
