


# Welcome to Maple Ridge is a growing multicultural community with a mixture of farmland. Melcome to Ridge Ridge British Columbia

## Our Programs

Maple Ridge Christian School is ranked within the top 10% of schools in British Columbia, according to the Fraser Institute school rankings. The school was built in 1956 and is expanding with a new building project (expected completion date of September 2024).

Kindergarten to Grade 12 students learn on the same campus and positive cross-grade interactions are witnessed each day. Students in all grades spend time weekly in our school library. There are opportunities to experience fine arts (music, drama, and art) and physical activities all year round.

### Elementary (Kindergarten to Gr. 5)

Early learning includes a mix of creativity, coaching, and connection. Students in our elementary program thrive academically and grow in their faith.





#### Middle School (Gr. 6-8)

These are years when youth discover and develop their strengths and passions. Students in our middle school program experience community as we intentionally combine grades 6 and 7 students. Collaboration takes place in the classroom and in athletics (available all year).

#### High School (Gr. 9-12)

Our graduates are proven to be problem solvers and critical thinkers who know how to work in teams and to relate to people of all ages. Teachers mentor students to dive deeper into academics, athletics, and the arts. High school students have the opportunity to attend various educational field trips with their classmates.

## Homestay

Our host families are an important component in the success of our international education program. Students age 13 and older, who are not living with their own family, are placed with a host family. A host family provides a safe, secure, English-speaking Christian environment for the student, ensuring consistency between the home and school, so that the vision of Christian education is encouraged. The student will attend

a local church and participate in family activities and outings with their host family.

At the host home, the student will have a private room which includes a bed with bed linens, a desk, a place to store clothing, and access to laundry and bathroom facilities. Students are expected to contribute to keeping the home clean and tidy. All phones/devices will be handed into the host parents overnight.


