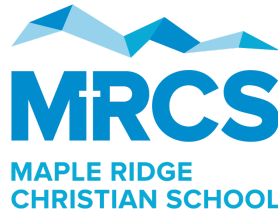

### PURPOSE

This policy is to provide the opportunity for homeschool learners to participate in MRCS sponsored extra-curricular, athletic programs at the high school level. To ensure sport teams have the minimum number of roster players, MRCS may consider partnering with homeschool learning families. While partnerships with outside families and organizations are possible, our priority is to serve enrolled families.

### PROCEDURES

- Homeschool learning students will only be eligible if they are **not registered** at any other public or independent school for the same sport
- Homeschool learning families wanting to apply for an extracurricular athletic program are to submit a completed application form
- An application and administration fee of \$500 will be charged per student-athlete in addition to a fee for each program the student participates in
- Consideration of acceptance is made dependent on space available for a specific sport
  - Participation on the team will not take the place of an enrolled MRCS student
  - Homeschool learners can be invited to tryouts for a team sport if there is a need for players for the team to be of sufficient size
  - Homeschool athletes are welcome to participate in individual athletic events such as cross-country and track and field
- Each application is reviewed by the Athletic Director and Lead Principal to determine eligibility; final decision rests with the Lead Principal
  - An application and invitation to tryout does not guarantee a roster spot
  - Fees will not be charged until a player is accepted on to the team
  - Players will be required to apply on an annual basis
